



Turvey Neighbourhood Plan update

Our Neighbourhood Plan

- Our Neighbourhood Plan provides the opportunity for residents to have a say in the way that development takes place in Turvey. It is mainly about the use and development of land but may also look at issues such as employment, transport, conservation, etc.

Recent progress and coming events

- A number of businesses responded to our Business Survey Questionnaire, providing useful information about the views of the business community in Turvey. The results will be published on the Neighbourhood Plan website and built into our forward planning.
- The ‘Village Discussion’ meeting took place in March and was well attended. There was general support for our Aims Statement and the proposed policy areas for the plan. We also received useful feedback about the site selection criteria we have developed for our appraisal of the sites put forward by local landowners for development. Notes from the group discussion sessions were recorded by group leaders and are published on the website alongside the revisions to the Aims and criteria made as a result of comments received.
- Site assessments have been carried out by AECOM planning consultants, funded by the government’s

Neighbourhood Plan programme. We will draw on their professional advice to assist our appraisal of sites against our own site selection criteria.

- The Steering Group has been considering the report from AECOM and will recommend what we believe to be the best options to the Parish Council
- After consulting the Parish Council we will present full details of the sites and our preferred options at a consultation event in the village hall where residents will have the opportunity to give us their views. This event will take place either in mid-July or mid-September depending on when we complete our consultation with the Parish Council.
- Our 'call for sites', where we invited landowners to come forward with new sites that they would wish to be considered for development in the Neighbourhood Plan, is closing on 29th June
